SUBCHAPTER 5. WATERFRONT SAFETY

- Specially exempt facility (not applicable with increased risk hazard)
- (5.1b) Owner or operator present
- (5.1d) Proper signage; prominently displayed
- (5.1g) Notification made to health authority of exemption claim

BATHING BEACH SUPERVISION

- (5.10a) Designated adult supervisor
- (5.10a3) Beach inspected 1x/week; documented on NJDOH checklist
- (5.10b) First Aid, CPR certified
- (5.10b2) Posted sign indicating location of first aid supplies
- (5.10c2) Min 2 lifeguards/300 ft any other bathing beach
- (5.10c4-7) Lifeguard(s) identified, no distractions, whistle
- (5.10d) Written SOP Aquatics Facility Plan, complete
- (5.10e) Lifeguard stations elevated, within 30' of shoreline, staffed
- (5.10f) Swimming area clean and safe; hazards marked
- (5.10g) Bathing beach designated (buoys, flags, other acceptable)

BATHER RULES

- (5.11) Bather rules & policies provided and posted

LIFESAVING EQUIPMENT

- (5.12a1) One 12 ft reach pole where appropriate (docks)
- (5.12a2) 1 rescue tube/can, or torpedo buoy w/ sufficient line attached
- (5.12a3) AED if can accommodate 500+ bathers or lifeguard present
- (5.12a4) Surfboard, rowboat, or similar which can support 2 adults
- (5.12a5) First aid kit meeting requirements at NJAC 8:26 Appendix B
- (5.12a6) Full spine board with ties, head restraints and/or straps
- (5.12a7) Emergency care room if can accommodate 500+ bathers
- (5.12a8) Telephone/other device; Emergency #'s, address posted

DIVING STANDS AND BOARDS

- (5.13a) Conform to rules at NJAC 8:26-5.5; prohibited in depths <8 ft
- (5.13b) Platforms conform; 1' air space; min depth maintained

WATERFRONT RESTRICTIONS

- (5.14) Posted, included language verbatim

SUBCHAPTER 6. GENERAL SANITATION & MAINTENANCE

- (6.1a) Facility clean, sanitary, safe condition
- (6.1,2,4) Dressing rooms, bathrooms provided; adequate; equipped
- (6.12a,b) Recreational, playground devices inspected; log maintained

SUBCHAPTER 7. SAMPLING AND WATER QUALITY CRITERIA

- (7.15a) Pre-operational assessment, documented on Checklist
- (7.15b) Pre-operational assessment, Checklist submitted
- (7.16a-e) Sampled appropriate; intervals; field data documented

- (7.18) E. coli (fresh) counts acceptable
